Marais Players Inc. Scholarship Requirements

Brief History:

The Marais Players Inc, an area based, community theatre was formed in 1971. The group's purpose is to provide live theater entertainment to the area and to encourage the involvement of people interested acting, directing, set design, and any other aspect relative to live theater We strive to present high quality entertainment at a reasonable cost.

Who is Eligible:

- 1) Current year graduate of Mayville or high school serving current Marais Players Inc. members.**
- 2) Applicants must maintain a minimum of a "C" average.**
- 3) Students must be enrolled at a recognized two-year vocational/junior college or four year post secondary institution.**

4) Students must be pursuing theatrical studies to include Music Majors if they have a significant portion of class load engaged in Music theater productions.

To be eligible each student must verify that they are taking acting/theater courses.

Amount of Scholarship:

This scholarship is in the amount of (2) \$300.00. This may be renewed annually if the candidate is chosen from a field of both current and future applicants. Depending on the number of applicants for the scholarship, the Marais Players Inc. reserve the right to modify the dollar amount with the minimum being \$300.00.

How Paid:

Payments will be made in two installments following verification through a copy of the class schedule. The second payment will be made after the Marais Players Inc. receives a copy of the first semester grades and a second semester class schedule. The Marais Players Inc. reserves the right to verify compliance with the terms of the scholarship.
